Week 14

### MONDAY

1

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Peru (31,774,225); Tuvalu (9,943); Romania (19,372,734); Saudi Arabia (32,157,974).

### TUESDAY

2

Please pray for Ruzanna and Binho as they faithfully minister the Gospel and equip Christians in São Paulo, Brazil. Pray God's truth would be relevant and applicable, and that the local team would know God's encouragement through His word.

### WEDNESDAY

3

Pray for the GCS Tanzania workers as they look to minister in the southern area of Makamba in southern Burundi. Pray for the team as they explore ways to build relationships with the local community.

### THURSDAY

4

Pray for our GCS partners in Belgium as they translate key evangelistic literature over the coming month. Pray for understanding and accuracy for those involved in translation of teaching materials and resources.

### FRIDAY

5

GCS is in great need of regular funds for our projected growth, operation, ministries and projects. Pray that God will meet all our needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19).

### SATURDAY

6

Pray for the GCS Canada team as they minister the Gospel in difficult contexts in both French and English speaking provinces. Pray for people to hear the Gospel where it has been misrepresented.

### SUNDAY

7

Preparation is taking place for a major 2020 evangelistic campaign to Ghana. Pray for more opportunities to partner in mobilizing the Ghanaian church for mission. Pray for a desire among believers to love the lost, and the strategies and tools to evangelise.

Week 15

### MONDAY

8

Pray for God to provide adequate evangelistic resources to support and sustain the spread of the Gospel in Liberia. Pray for Liberian church leaders to be equipped through theological and pastoral training to withstand the onslaught of false gospels.

### TUESDAY

9

When our brothers and sisters take the Gospel into the nations, they are going into a war. The devil is dead set on destroying souls and diverting mission. Pray for their victory in spiritual warfare (See: Acts 13:10–12).

### WEDNESDAY

10

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Russia (143,439,832); Yemen (27,477,600); Belgium (11,371,928); Estonia (1,309,104).

### THURSDAY

11

Pray for the ongoing work taking place in secondary schools and sixth form colleges across the UK. Pray that young people attending class and assembly presentations will be impacted by the Gospel and that their lives will be changed.

### FRIDAY

12

Pray for Christian ministries across the world attempting to communicate the Gospel over the internet. Pray that God will give them creativity and clarity to communicate the Gospel in an uncompromising way.

### SATURDAY

13

Christian TV is transmitted into Iran by satellite TV, reaching the private living rooms of families that otherwise may never have heard the Gospel. Pray that more people would come across Christian channels, and that nothing will hinder the Gospel.

### SUNDAY

14

Pray for the GCS missionaries travelling throughout April, both nationally and internationally. Pray for protection and provision during travel, and for God's grace and favour when challenges or obstacles appear on any journey.

Week 16

### MONDAY

15 Srap and Nazeli run regular evangelical services and training workshops across Armenia. Pray for stamina, good health and God’s provision as they continue to spread the Gospel, equip believers, and build fruitful collaborations.

### TUESDAY

16 Pray for strength and stamina as GCS missionaries encounter antagonistic spiritual forces (Ephesians 6:10–18). Pray that people will resist Satan’s plans to obstruct the spread of the Gospel (James 4:7). Pray that God’s Word will spread rapidly.

### WEDNESDAY

17 Pray for Umberto from GCS Italy as he networks with church leaders and workers across the northern city of Turin to organise evangelistic missions in prisons, schools, churches and on the streets.

### THURSDAY

18 Pray for our GCS partners in Cameroon that continue to provide training and equipping in evangelism to churches across the country. Pray God gives them wisdom and compassion as they continue to work with churches of different denominations.

### GOOD FRIDAY

19 Give thanks and praise to God for loving the world so much that He gave His one and only Son to die on the cross to pay the price for our sins. Pray for all of God’s children to recapture the joy of salvation and share the good news of salvation with the world.

### SATURDAY

20 EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Greece (10,919,459); Montenegro (626,101); Vatican City (840); Honduras (8,189,501).

### EASTER SUNDAY

21 Pray that many people would come to know Christ in all walks of life from the faithful witness of our GCS missionaries. “When the proconsul saw what had happened, he believed, for he was amazed at the teaching about the Lord.” (Acts 13:12)

Week 17

### MONDAY

22 Pray for GCS workers serving in India, who face pressure from many changes and challenges taking place across the country, which creates uncertainty and concern. Pray for wisdom as they seek to equip Christians in hostile environments.

### TUESDAY

23 Pray for more workers in India to minister amongst communities where Jesus is least known. Pray for revival, repentance and boldness in churches and missionaries nationwide in the face of persecution.

### WEDNESDAY

24 Pray for the GCS UK team as they minister the Gospel and personal testimonies to the residents at the 'Carpenter's Arms' in Leicestershire. Pray for this vital Christian ministry that seeks to rehabilitate and restore broken lives.

### THURSDAY

25 Pray for good working relationships with Christian workers and church leaders in Bhutan. Pray for Christians to stand firm and multiply despite harsh treatment and harassment.

### FRIDAY

26 Pray for human rights abuses against the Nepali Bhutanese to be replaced by love and compassion in the name of Christ. Pray for Bhutan's population of 826,299 to hear and positively respond to the Gospel.

### SATURDAY

27 Pray for the GCS Board of Directors meeting to oversee, discuss and pray for the ministry. Pray for the new members joining the Board to have a smooth transition into their new roles, as they pick up the baton of governance.

### SUNDAY

28 Pray for the search of a Central Europe Regional Director. Pray that God would bring the right leader to GCS with the right calling, conviction, character and calibre to lead the ministry forward in this region.
