Week 18

WEDNESDAY

1

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: New Zealand (4,565,185); Panama (3,990,406); Georgia (3,979,781); Sri Lanka (20,810,816).

THURSDAY

2

Pray for the GCS Pakistan team in Lahore as they install another water-well in the Kasur district of Punjab. Pray for strong relationships to be built up with members of the village community, and for wisdom and safety as they share the Gospel.

FRIDAY

3

Life cannot be sustained without water, and in Pakistan over 68 million people do not have access to adequate sanitation. Pray God will provide the necessary financial resources for GCS to install water-wells over the next 4 years.

SATURDAY

4

Pray for breakthrough in reaching spiritually oppressed people living in areas of Pakistan currently beyond the reach of a Christian witness. Pray that Christians will find effective ways to evangelise, and for the strongholds of evil to be broken.

SUNDAY

5

Pray for the GCS Directors running in the London Tough Mudder to raise funding for evangelistic ministry. Pray for physical stamina for those taking part, and for more supporters to donate to the ministry.

Week 19

MONDAY

6

Give thanks for the newly appointed members that have joined the GCS UK Board of Directors. Pray that God will give to each of them the wisdom to govern, and the vision to direct the global ministry of GCS.

TUESDAY

7

Pray that the global Church will catch a fresh vision of the lost multitudes and be moved with compassion by the Spirit of God to fulfil the Great Commission (Matthew 9:37-38).

WEDNESDAY

8

Give thanks to God for making it possible for GCS to expand its global reach with teams established in 42 nations. Pray for the development of more Spirit-filled facilitators for the transforming governance and mission projects in each region.

THURSDAY

9

Pray for the world's estimated population of 7.7 billion people to hear the message of the Gospel in 2019. Pray that every Christian will be raised up to boldly proclaim the Gospel to the world in a loving way and without compromise.

FRIDAY

10

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: South Sudan (12,733,427); Uganda (40,322,768); Zambia (16,717,332); Myanmar (54,363,426).

SATURDAY

11

11 to 21 May: Pray for the evangelistic outreach meetings and evangelism training schools taking place in Armenia over the coming weeks. Pray that many Christians would be equipped and mobilised for personal evangelism and discipleship.

SUNDAY

12

Pray for the people of Armenia, steeped in the rituals of the Armenian Apostolic Church, and yet estranged from a personal relationship with Christ. Pray for access to the Word of God, and that through it many may find the truth of the Gospel.

Week 20

MONDAY

13

The present leaders of the Armenian Apostolic Churches have taken a strong stand against evangelism. Pray for repentant hearts, renewed minds, and a fresh revelation in their faith to not hinder the spread of the Gospel any further.

TUESDAY

14

Pray for the GCS team in Armenia to seek effective ways to spread the Gospel in addition to working alongside different organisations and churches to train as well as equip Christians in evangelism. Pray for Armenia to be transformed by God's love.

WEDNESDAY

15

Pray for the physical and emotional life of every GCS worker that lives and works in difficult climates, where diseases are prevalent. Pray for every GCS worker's financial, physical, spiritual and emotional needs to be met (2 Thessalonians 2:16-17).

THURSDAY

16

Pray for the GCS Canada Board of Directors meeting in Toronto to oversee, discuss and pray for the ministry. Pray that each board member will have God given wisdom and vision to govern, direct and pioneer the ministry of GCS across Canada.

FRIDAY

17

Pray for the GCS Canada team working with street children in Cochabamba, Bolivia. Pray for direction, inspiration and safety as they build relationships, provide education, and communicate the Gospel with homeless street children.

SATURDAY

18

Pray for each of the 11,052,864 people who live in Bolivia to hear the Gospel. Pray that the evangelical believers in Bolivia will be spiritually equipped for evangelism and discipleship.

SUNDAY

19

Pray for the evangelistic youth rally taking place today in Copenhagen city centre in Denmark. Pray that many non-Christians from the local community will attend, and the Gospel will be proclaimed clearly.

Week 21

MONDAY

20

As GCS advance the spread and proclamation of the Gospel we have set a budget for evangelistic operations, ministry communications and basic ministry needs. Pray that GCS will see a much needed increase in regular financial support.

TUESDAY

21

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Norway (5,271,958); San Marino (31,950); Spain (46,064,604); Sweden (9,851,852); Switzerland (8,379,477).

WEDNESDAY

22

Pray for open doors for the Gospel as 'AFL Sports' in Malaysia work in closer partnership with both Christian and secular sports associations. Pray that God might sustain the team as they develop and implement their sports programme.

THURSDAY

23

The third annual GCS School of Evangelism and Discipleship starts today in Kiev, Ukraine. Give thanks for the good number of students that have enrolled for 2019, and pray for each of them to be equipped and mobilised for ministry.

FRIDAY

24

Pray for the evangelistic outreach meetings and church ministry taking place in Cluj, Romania this weekend. Pray that the Gospel message will be proclaimed clearly, and for every unchurched guest to receive Christ as their personal Saviour.

SATURDAY

25

Pray that God might open doors for the Gospel to be preached in all places and to all peoples. Pray that God might grant a holy boldness to Christians so that they will have the courage to proclaim the Gospel in every opportunity (Colossians 4:3).

SUNDAY

26

Pray for the National Team Leaders in GCS as they keep national ministries following God's agenda and help them be the best stewards of the resources that God has given them and be effective in developing national leaders.

27

MONDAY

Pray for our GCS partners in Pabianice and Łódź in central Poland, as they reach their local communities and penetrate its largely Catholic population with the Gospel. Pray for hearts to be open to the message of salvation among the materialistic youth.

Pray for the GCS partners in Poland as they continue to work alongside churches of diverse cultures and denominations to help build momentum in the spread of the Gospel. Pray for more national missionaries to take the Gospel to other Slavic nations.

29

WEDNESDAY

Pray for a powerful move of the Holy Spirit across Sudan, for many to hear the truth of the Gospel of peace and reconciliation, and for people to come to faith in the God who offers life, hope and healing.

30

THURSDAY

Pray for the GCS team presently serving in South Sudan. Please pray for approval to be granted to those renewing their visas, for the security and safety for the ground team and their on-going work.

31

FRIDAY

EVERY COUNTRY 2019: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Ethiopia (101,853,268); Ghana (28,033,375); Mozambique (28,751,362); India (1,326,801,576).
