Week 9

SUNDAY

1 EVERY COUNTRY 2020: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Angola (22,587,523); Sierra Leone (6,541,574); Japan (126,130,865); Qatar (2,118,694).

Week 10

MONDAY

2 Pray for Melvin and Laura as they continue to spread the Gospel in Algeria. Pray for wisdom and safety as Melvin builds bridges each day with Muslims, and as he boldly shares the Gospel.

TUESDAY

3 Pray for every National Team Leader in GCS to keep their sub-teams focused on God's agenda, to help them be the best stewards of the resources God has given them, and to be effective in carrying out the great commission.

WEDNESDAY

4 Pray for the students at SMBS in Florida as they continue studies and ministry preparation. Praise God for the passion and enthusiasm of these young believers and pray that God shines through their words and actions.

THURSDAY

5 Pray for the work of GCS and eCapture as they continue to record and produce episodes for the new GCS Podcast. Pray that this audio resource will play a significant part in equipping Christians to evangelise.

FRIDAY

6 Pray for the evangelistic outreach meetings and evangelism training schools taking place in Dunoon over the coming weekend. Pray that many local Christians would be equipped to evangelise, and the Gospel message will be proclaimed clearly.

SATURDAY

7 Pray for the planning and preparation for an evangelistic campaign to Nigeria in 2020. Pray that Nigerian Christians will be better equipped to evangelise and that the population of 183.5 million people will have an opportunity to hear the Gospel.

SUNDAY

8 EVERY COUNTRY 2020: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: South Sudan (12,733,427); Uganda (40,322,768); Zambia (16,717,332); Myanmar (54,363,426).

Week 11

MONDAY

9 Pray for opportunities for GCS workers serving in Morocco to share the Gospel in tightly knit Islamic communities. Pray that the seeds sown will begin to bear fruit, and for people to receive Christ into their hearts.

TUESDAY

10 Pray for the GCS UK team as they minister the Gospel and share personal testimonies to the residents at the 'Carpenter's Arms' in Leicestershire. Pray for this vital Christian ministry that seeks to rehabilitate and restore broken lives.

WEDNESDAY

11 Pray for the development work taking place in 2020 to make each regional GCS team fully functioning and self-sustaining. Pray for more workers to be raised in each region and that local supporters will register interest in the work.

THURSDAY

12 Pray for the GCS team in Italy to have continual wisdom and compassion as they attempt to work alongside churches of different cultures and denominations to help build momentum in the spread of the Gospel.

FRIDAY

13 Pray for Italians enslaved by tradition or disillusioned with church structures, to encounter the living Christ. Pray that nominal Christians throughout Italy will grasp a true understanding of the Gospel and for the power of God to be revealed.

SATURDAY

14 Pray for the GCS mission taking place in N'Djamena in the Republic of Chad over the next 5 days. Pray that the Gospel campaigns will reach as many people as possible, and for safety, boldness and wisdom.

SUNDAY

15 EVERY COUNTRY 2020: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Germany (80,682,351); Ukraine (44,624,373); Grenada (107,327); Tonga (106,915).

Week 12

MONDAY

16 Pray for the workshops taking place this week in Secondary Schools across South London. Pray for the Gospel to be communicated clearly and sensitively through the presentations and for good relationships to be established with the teaching staff.

TUESDAY

17 Pray for the GCS team preparing for the next JAM (Jesus And Music) Gospel concert tour across Eastern Europe this Easter 2020. Pray that the Gospel will fall on open ears, and that lives would be transformed by the Gospel.

WEDNESDAY

18 Pray for the long-term GCS worker presently serving in Sudan. Pray that the recent shipment of aid and literature will reach the people in greatest need, and for the security and safety of the ground team.

THURSDAY

19 Pray for the GCS Publishing Label to continually maintain strong evangelistic focus, and that each title will achieve commercial appeal, editorial integrity, excellent branding and design, and be effective in communicating the Gospel.

FRIDAY

20 As the GCS team seek fresh ways to advance the spread and proclamation of the Gospel across the world, pray for a financial breakthrough that will cover the basic costs of the evangelistic missions, projects and daily running of the organisation.

SATURDAY

21 Pray for our GCS team in Sweden as they lead their third annual Evangelism Conference in Stockholm. Pray for the evangelistic ministry that will be taking place in the evenings with the homeless.

SUNDAY

22 EVERY COUNTRY 2020: Pray that every person in each of the following 4 countries will hear and respond positively to the Gospel message: Kuwait (4,007,146); Oman (4,654,471); Austria (8,569,633); Serbia (8,812,705).

Week 13

MONDAY

23

Pray for the GCS Myanmar associate Rev. Bawi Ceu (Joseph) and the believers at Emmanuel Church as they seek to impact the Buddhist community in Kalaymyo. Pray for wisdom, courage and safety as they apply different methods of sharing the Gospel.

TUESDAY

24

Pray for GCS Missionaries to stand firm under affliction and to look forward to eternal glory. “For our momentary light affliction is producing for us an absolutely incomparable eternal weight of glory” (2 Corinthians 4:17).

WEDNESDAY

25

Pray that more Christians would use their careers to take the Gospel to places it's never been. Pray that God stirs the hearts of Christians to be more vocal about their faith and communicate the Gospel in relevant and effective ways.

THURSDAY

26

Pray for Japan's population of 127,125,332 people to hear, understand and embrace the Gospel message. Pray for the spread and proclamation of the Gospel to build momentum in Japan, and for it to take root in Japanese culture.

FRIDAY

27

Pray for Christians serving in Japan to adapt to how society and the younger generation is quickly changing. Pray they will proclaim the Christian message in a relevant way that connects to people's hearts and is sensitive to the times.

SATURDAY

28

Pray for the Body of Christ in Japan within a culture that discourages standing out and being different. Pray that Christians would have the courage to speak about Jesus Christ, and that more people would come to know Him.

SUNDAY

29

Most Japanese people do not know a Christian and have little idea what the Gospel is about. Pray for Japanese Christians and missionaries to be bold and creative in making Jesus known in their families, neighbourhoods, workplaces and schools.

MONDAY

30

Pray for the people in Pakistan living in severe poverty. Brick kiln owners and landowners take advantage by offering high-interest loans and trapping them in bonded labour. Pray for deliverance for those trapped in slavery in Pakistan.

TUESDAY

31

Pray for the work GCS and its partners are doing in prisons across South Africa reaching inmates with the Gospel, the follow up discipleship programmes, and training believers in practical evangelism.
