HOW TO LEAD SOMEONE TO CHRIST USING THE EVANGECUBE

1 Show 'Man in Sin' separated from 'God'



- This light (point to the right side) represents God.
- God is perfect and without sin.
- God loves us!
- God doesn't want us to perish, but to have everlasting life.
- But our sins must be removed in order to have eternal life with God.
- This figure (point to the left side) represents every person like you and me.
- The darkness represents our sin.
- Sin is anything that God tells us not to do.
- The Bible says "...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,." (Romans 3:23)
- Our sins separate us from God.

2 Open to 'Christ on the Cross'

- God loved us so much that He sent His Son Jesus Christ to earth as a man. Jesus, who was fully God, became fully man and was able to live a perfect life.
- God made Jesus die on a cross to pay for our sins with His blood. He took our sins in His body on the cross so that we could come to God (1 Peter 2:24, 3:18).
- The Bible also says "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)
- The Bible says, "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8)



3 Open to the 'Tomb'



- Men buried Jesus in a tomb.
- They rolled a huge stone in front of it.
- Soldiers guarded the tomb.

4 Open to 'Risen Christ'



- God sent an angel to roll away the big stone and scare away the soldiers.
- God raised Jesus from the dead!
- Soon afterward, God took Jesus back to heaven.
- Jesus has paid the price for our sin, and Jesus has conquered death.

5 Open to 'Cross Bridge'

- Jesus is the only way we can come to God.
- Jesus said in the Bible, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." (John 14:6)
- Through Jesus, we can be forgiven of all our sins and be with God forever.
- But just knowing about these things is not enough! We must choose to put our faith in Jesus, repent of our sin and surrender our lives to Him in daily service.
- If you do not take the step of trusting in Jesus, then your sins are not removed! (Hebrews 4:2)



6 Open to 'Heaven & Hell'

- The Bible says that whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them! (John 3:16, 18, 36).
- The penalty for sin is death, but eternal life through Jesus is a free gift from God.
- What choice will you make?
- Trust in Jesus Christ to be forgiven and have eternal life? (point to 'heaven')
- Or reject Jesus Christ and suffer eternal punishment in fire? (point to 'hell')



ASK THE QUESTION:

**Would you like to trust in Jesus
right now and be saved?
(if YES, continue)**

(if yes) The Bible says, "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." (Romans 10:9) I can lead us in a prayer to God. Remember, it's not saying the words that saves you; God is looking at your heart for true faith in Jesus. Ready? (if yes) Let's pray:

"Dear God, thank You for loving me. I confess that I have sinned against You. I believe that Your Son Jesus died on the cross, to pay for my sins, and that You raised Jesus from the dead. I now put my faith only in Jesus and repent of all the things I have done wrong in my life. Please forgive me, and save me from my sins. I now confess that Jesus is Lord! Thank you for your gift of eternal life. I pray in the name of Your Son, our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen."

7 Steps for Followers of Christ!



LOVE God and all people.

Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'" (Matthew 22:37-39)



STUDY the Bible (God's Word) daily.

Start with the Gospel of John; read 1 chapter each day. "Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation" (1 Peter 2:2)
"Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them. (John 14:23)



PRAY to God constantly.

In prayer you can thank and worship God, ask for His help, confess your sins, and pray for others. " Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7)



MEET regularly with other Christians.

God commands that Christians meet regularly for worship, prayer, Bible study, and helping each other. "...not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25)



TELL others the good news about Jesus.

God wants us to tell other people How to Have Eternal Life with God by trusting in Jesus to save them from sin. You can use this paper when you talk to others about Jesus! "He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." (Mark 16:15)

MULTIPLY YOUR MINISTRY

God wants your church to grow and multiply. God does that as we obey the commands of Christ and follow the model of ministry used by the Apostle Paul. Here's what the Bible says about how to do this.



GOD'S HEART

Pray for God to give your church His heart for how He wants you to obey His Great Commission in Matthew 28:19-20. Follow the church planting ministry of the Apostle Paul as a model for how to multiply your church's ministry (Acts 14:21-28):

- **Pray** (Acts 14:23)
- **Evangelise** (Acts 14: 21, 25)
- **Make Disciples** (Acts 14:21-22)
- **Gather Together** (Acts 14:23)
- **Develop Leaders** (Acts 14:23)
- **Multiply** (Acts 14:26-28)



MAKE DISCIPLES

Provide someone to disciple all new believers to help them obey the commands of Christ. We must obey Jesus' command in Matthew 28:19-20: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."



GATHER TOGETHER

Gather together believers into a healthy church. Acts 2:42-47 gives us an excellent example of a loving and caring church. Believers grow spiritually and people are attracted to Christ as believers meet together to obey the commands of Jesus.



PRAY

Pray for labourers for God's harvest fields.. "Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. 38 Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." (Matthew 9:37-38)

Pray for a ministry plan. Pray for God to give your church a plan to do ministry and missions as He gave the church in Antioch in Acts 13:1-5.



DEVELOP LEADERS

Help disciples grow to become servant leaders. Choose faithful disciples and help them grow into servant leaders, just as Paul did with Timothy. (2 Timothy 2:1-6 and 3:10-11)



EVANGELISE

Use the EvangeCube to tell others the good news about Jesus. Train your church members how to tell other people how to have eternal life with God by trusting only in Jesus to save them from sin. "He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." (Mark 16:15)



MULTIPLY

Ask God to multiply your church's ministry, as Jesus commanded in Acts 1:8: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Trust God to enable you to mobilise your church to plant new churches in God's harvest fields.
